How to Enter

- Read the Conditions of Entry (see attached)
- Fill out the entry form and email or deliver to the Exhibition Co-ordinator (see attached)

Conditions of Entry

- Open to all artists including schools and community groups.
- Artwork must be original
- All exhibits will be displayed in Lloyd Mann Gardens, Home Hill.
- A maximum of 10 exhibits will compete for the prize money
- Others artist can still exhibit if not accepted in first 10
- Non-competitive exhibits can be displayed alongside competing exhibits.
- The \$300.00 Artist's fee payable by the Home Hill Harvest Festival Committee will be available for each of the 10 successful entries to go towards costs associated with the exhibit. \$150.00 provided initially and the remaining \$150.00 upon installation and judging.
- The entry form must be fully and correctly completed by the due date to be considered for the Artist's fee.
- Successful entrants MUST produce an exhibit for the Ephemera or will be required <u>refund the</u> deposit of \$150
- The exhibit is of a standard that is acceptable by the Committee.
- Exhibits can be advertised for sale. The exhibit must be accompanied with a price tag if for sale. Commission on sales will be levelled at 10% to the Home Hill Harvest Festival Committee.
- The awards will be announced at the Harvest Festival Mardi Gras on Saturday 9 November, 2024
- All exhibits must remain on display until the end of the Harvest Festival period in November.

Factors to be taken into consideration by the Artist

- What materials are at your disposal?
- What recycled materials can be utilised?
- How does your artwork address the current contemporary art Diaspora?
- How does your artwork respond to the site you have chosen?
- What is the potential and suitability for public interaction?
- How will your work be displayed and viewed day and night?
- Due to the tropical climate of Home Hill, we tend to experience strong winds and rain, have you taken these environmental factors into consideration when planning your artwork?
- What are the potential health and safety aspects of your work? What issues may arise?
- How will you secure your sculpture without causing permanent damage to the natural environment?
- What skills are required to complete your work? Will you need to arrange additional help?
- What is your ability to complete the proposed work on time?

Judging Criteria

The exhibits will be judged using the following criteria:

- Preference will be given to larger works
- Visual appeal and the idea behind the installation
- Provocation of emotional response/discussion
- Originality of concept
- Time and effort put into the creation of the exhibit
- Fulfilment of the Artist's intent
- Use of materials
- Use of colour
- Use of technique
- Other responsibilities.
- Important it's the Artists responsibility for the installation and the dismounting
- The entry form and drawing/photo or other reference need to be supplied
- The work must have not been in any other competitions or displayed publicly.
